The EHFNA Board recommends loaning \$55,000 to Propel Nonprofits (PropelNonprofits.org) for a 3 year term. Propel has been able to create a pool of funds to provide loans for important housing projects in Minneapolis including YouthLink, Urban Homeworks, PPL, and Alliance Housing. Currently they have funds from 8 Minneapolis neighborhoods. Interest will be earned at 1-1/2%. A neighborhood vote is required to allocate dollar amounts greater than \$25,000.
