Bike safety in East Harriet:

- 1) Lake Harriet Parkway, by the bandshell, heading west, where there is a 90 degree turn where the boat launch is. Getting across the road to the lake is difficult at this bend. Request is for signage and or painted stripes.
- 2) From 40th and Lyndale to the Roseway road, there are no bike lane markings. Requests have been made to have this area striped. Motorists are telling bikers to use the sidewalk.
- 3) The service road on Lake Harriet from Minnehaha parkway to 43rd street has bike lane striping that has faded. It is requested to be repainted.
- 4) Request has been made to have striping put down on Lake Harriet parkway between 43rd street and the Roseway road. When bikers come from Minnehaha parkway and want to head clockwise around the lake to the Rose garden, they take the service road to the intersection of 43rd and lake Harriet parkway. Getting to the rose garden from there is difficult with the blind turns and narrow road.

Fairskies: Budget has been submitted as of the June board meeting. CSTN committee is waiting for its approval.

Person of interest: Residents in north East Harriet are concerned about a resident who is approaching them for money and other items. This person is not aggressive, but is causing them to feel uncomfortable. Advice has been given. The CSTN committee will continue to follow this.
