Agenda:

- National Night Out: There were 16 blocks in East Harriet that signed up with the city for NNO. There were several other blocks that had gatherings, but did not register with the city. It was a very good night for residents to get together. Many blocks had either the police or a fire engine visit their block party.
- Courtwatch; The list of people of interest has been updated and available for viewing by way of the link on the East Harriet crime and safety page. Inspector Matt Clark has asked that 2 people be added to the list, which has been done.
- East Harriet crime: Below are the crimes committed in East Harriet between July 18th and August 15th.
 - **Burglary**
 - • 7/26 37xx Bryant-suspect gained access to four unlocked units in an apartment building and items were taken. The case was assigned to an investigator but it has been closed now due to lack of evidence.
 - • 8/14 38xx Aldrich-the victim was working in the yard when an unknown suspect entered the upper unit through an unlocked door. Jewelry and a purse were taken.
 - • 8/9 43xx Fremont-a suspect entered through an unlocked garage door and rifled through vehicles. The loss is unknown.
 - There were four thefts from motor vehicles during this time. Valuables were taken in each case.
