Minutes for October 15, 2012

Agenda:

- 1) 36th Street bike lane proposal: A meeting was held at the Bryant park building with representatives of CARAG ECCO and East Harriet and councilperson Meg Tuthill present. Discussion surrounded which type of bike lane to put in on 36th street between Lake Calhoun and Dupont/Kings Highway. CARAG has put in \$10,000 towards the funding of the bike lane. ECCO has tentatively agreed to fund \$9,000. At this time the city does not have funding for a bike lane project on 36th street. Of the 4 proposals, the most costly one would be around \$90,000. The least expensive is roughly \$9,000. Concerns of the intersection of 36th and Lake Calhoun Parkway were brought up.
